2015 Annual Report to the Public



The Town of Ballston Community Library was able to complete renovations that include a new computer room, a reorganized staff space, a storage closet, and a new circulation desk with the help of a \$132,364 NYS Library Construction Grant, a \$5,000 Southern Adirondack Library System Grant, \$10,000 from Senator Hugh Farley, and \$5,000 from the Friends of the Library. Renovations started in November 2015 and were completed in February of 2016.
