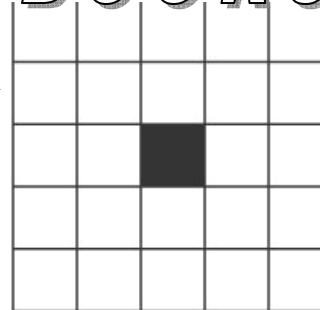
She met her husband while attending college at Mankato State University, in Mankato, Minnesota. Lynn and her husband have four children, including a set of twins.
