

The Town of Ballston Community Library will be participating in "Dream Big—Read!" as a part of the 2012 Summer Reading at New York Libraries Program by offering free programs that include books, crafts and activities for all children from babies to teens. Studies show that summer reading helps with school success all year! Sign-up begins at 10:00 AM on Saturday, June 23 in the Children's Room. All children, infants to teens, are invited to sign up for our program. Our Summer Reading Program will run June 25 through August 3.
