#### **A New Sign for The Town of Ballston Community Library**

The Town of Ballston Community Library has a new way to let the community keep in touch with what's happening at the library. The two existing exterior signs are being replaced by a single color digital sign, paid for in large part by a grant from Senator Hugh Farley.

When the library surveyed the community in preparation for writing the 2013-2016 Long Range Plan, community members told the library that the sign was the best way to let them know about programs and events at the library, but the existing message sign is in poor condition and easily vandalized, in addition to being difficult to reach during the winter months due to the snow banks.

The library trustees and staff worked with the Town of Ballston to assure that the sign would meet town guidelines and be a good fit for the neighborhood. Because it is programmable, it can be turned off at night to ensure that it will not disturb library neighbors.

The sign will be dedicated to Senator Hugh Farley, in recognition of his support of New York State Libraries and to thank him especially for his long-standing support of the Town of Ballston Community Library.
