PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Town of Ballston, in association with the New York State Broadband Program Office, Cornell University Cooperative Extension, Hudson Valley Wireless and Town of Ballston Library have developed a program to provide a new benefit to our area seniors. The goal of the program is to help enrich the lives of our area seniors by becoming more "digitally literate". This will be accomplished by helping them access a vast array of resources available on the Internet.

A senior who has an iPAD and a wireless connection can get news, read books, communicate with relatives, watch movies, get access to healthcare, deal with our Federal and State governments, shop, work on their hobbies and about anything else you can think of.
