## Read with us

The Town of Ballston Community Library and Burnt Hills-Ballston Lake Central Schools are participating in "Build a Better World" as part of the 2017 Summer Reading at New York Libraries Program. Studies show that reading at least 20 minutes per day during the summer helps with school success all year! All participants (babies—adults) are invited to log their time spent reading this summer.

## How to log

Starting May 30, participants may enroll in our Summer Reading Program by visiting the Library's website (<http://tobllibrary.sals.edu>) or in person at the Library. If you need help registering or have any questions, we are happy to assist you. All children and teens must be enrolled in the Summer Reading Program to attend programs or activities. Program registration for weeks 1-3 begins on June 19th and reading logs begin on June 23rd.
