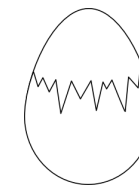

MS Excel 2003 Part 3 – Learn how to paste special, link cells, worksheets, and workbooks. Tuesday, April 13: 6-8 PM

MS Excel 2003 Part 4 - Learn how to use mathematical operations, conditional formatting, and transposition. Tuesday, April 20: 6-8PM

MS Excel 2003 Part 1 - This course is for the beginner to intermediate user. Learn how to build a basic spreadsheet from the ground up. Wednesday, May 5: 6-8PM

"The Battle and the Park"

How many know that there is a National Park just 29 miles north of the Albany Airport? It is the Saratoga National Historical Park, which preserves lands on which the Battles of Saratoga were fought in September and October, 1777 during America's revolutionary war.

It introduces you to the people, places and events on the American and British sides in what has been called the turning point of the American Revolution.

It explains what happened to the people and the land after the war. It describes how the battlefield became first a New York state historic site and was later transformed by President Franklin Roosevelt into the Saratoga National Historical Park. The presentation takes you on a tour of the present day park grounds located in Stillwater, NY and at its adjunct sites in Schuylerville, NY. Perhaps it will entice you to visit the park and experience its history and serenity.
