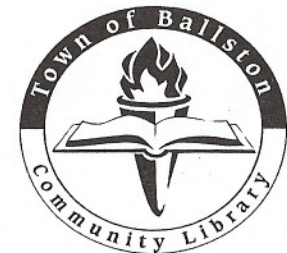

# RESOURCES

The Town of Ballston Community Library has a collection of approximately 60,000 items, including books, newspapers, magazines, audio books, videos, CDs, DVDs and other items. The Library adds about 5000 items yearly.

Community Library borrowers cards are honored at all 60+ other Southern Adirondack and Mohawk Valley Libraries in the local 8-county region.

## LIBRARY SERVICES

Most library services are FREE, including: all loans, first borrowers' cards, reserves, most programs, story times and high speed internet access.

The Library gives parents the option of limiting their children's access to R-rated videos and DVDs. Ask for more information and an application at the Circulation Desk

A meeting room that accommodates 50 is available for local community organizations to use. Art exhibit and display space can be reserved by individuals on a first come, first served basis.
