During week three, you may sign up for week four, five and six programs (July 21-August 8). You may attend as many of the non-registration programs as you'd like. Please CALL if you cannot make it to a program you are registered to attend. Anyone who is a no call/no show not be able to register for any future programs this summer.

- Click View Log to track your reading, write reviews and see your progress.
- Each time you log in, the website will let you know how many prizes you're eligible for and how many minutes you need to read to reach the next prize level.
