### Volunteers

As part of the Summer Reading Program, students entering grades 6—12 can earn community service hours by volunteering at the Library. Our summer volunteer program runs June 27—August 5 and volunteers can sign up for one shift. Each volunteer will select a two hour time slot and will come at that day/time for the six weeks of Summer Reading (for example Mondays from 1:00 PM—3:00 PM). Volunteers must be available at least four of the six weeks to participate. We will have a volunteer sign-up and informational meeting on May 31 at 6:30 PM, potential volunteers must attend with a parent or guardian and will choose their time slot at this meeting. Volunteers must also attend one training session before Summer Reading begins, either Monday, June 6 at 6:30 PM or Saturday, June 11 at 10:30 AM.

# **Reading Challenge**

The Reading Challenge is June 20<sup>th</sup> – September 5<sup>th</sup> and is open to everyone from babies to teens. This is your opportunity to track your reading, complete challenges and earn prizes. Our online reading log (<a href="http://toblibrary.sals.edu">http://toblibrary.sals.edu</a>) will keep track and let you know when you're eligible for prizes. You may redeem prizes from June 27<sup>th</sup> – August 12<sup>th</sup> at the library. Reading logs continue until September 5<sup>th</sup> but the last day for prizes and the Raffle Drawing will be August 12<sup>th</sup>. The Library Staff will track our reading too, we've set a goal of each reading at least 1000 minutes this summer. See if you can read more than us!

## **Programs & Activities**

Program sign up is now online through the Library's website (<a href="http://toblibrary.sals.edu">http://toblibrary.sals.edu</a>). Each program is listed on our online calendar with all the information about program dates and times, age groups and when you can sign up. Program sign up begins on June 20<sup>th</sup>. You can sign up online, over the phone or in person at the library. In order to participate in programs you must first be enrolled in the Summer Reading Program. Please CALL if you cannot make it to a program you are registered to attend. If you are a no call/no show you will not be able to register for any future programs during the Summer Reading Program.
